

## Literature distribution in Albania and Angola



Dear Friend, What a tremendous blessing and privilege it has been to proclaim God's love to the nations over the last 75 years. Ephesians chap 2 v 4 tells us of God's GREAT love: 'But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us.' John chap 3 v 16 tells us that God SO loved: 'For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.'

In this report you will read of God's leading in the past regarding the commencement of the Every Home Crusade. You will also read of what God is doing in the world in these days. We give Him all the glory.

The hymn writer put it well when these words were penned:

'And when I think that God His son not sparing,  
Sent Him to die I scarce can take it in,  
That on the cross my burden gladly bearing,  
He bled and died to take away my sin.'



On the 15th of January we shipped a container of Spanish literature to Bolivia, South America. In this container we sent supplies of literature to 4 different groups that we work with in the country. Those receiving literature were Pastor Peniel, Pastor Jose Luis, CEF and Every Home for Christ.

On the 23rd of January we shipped a container to Every Home for Christ in Uruguay. We included in this container almost 4 Million Gospel Tracts, 20,000 Gospels of John, 1,500 New Testaments and 1,000 Sets of Children's Bible Lessons.

On the 25th of January – we shipped a container

consisting of 360,000 Gospels of John. This container is going to a restricted country – please pray that this container will be able to clear customs and that these Gospels will be of great benefit in a very difficult country.

On the 31st January we shipped a pallet of Flashcard Bible Lessons to CEF in Portugal.

We also shipped two pallets of CEF Flashcard Bible Lessons to a restricted country.

## Albania

Dear Samuel, Greetings from Albania! We want to share with you an update regarding the distribution of the literature by our ministry. Thousands of people and families were reached with the Gospel during the last months. In cooperation with many Churches we have distributed evangelistic literature home to home, in the roads, parks and in the promenade of the cities and villages. Also, we have organised events and activities during the National Evangelistic Day, Children's Day, events with youth and students and literature distribution camps.

The Word of God has blessed and transformed many lives. New believers are connected with the local churches. 15 new believers got baptised. Many people send us prayer requests and our praying teams pray for their needs.

Our volunteers visited their family, gave them literature and a package of clothes and shared the gospel with them. Selviko was so happy

to hear the Good News, she prayed and accepted Jesus as her Lord and Saviour. We gave her a Bible. Also, her granddaughters wanted to learn more about Jesus. We gave them a Children’s Bible. It is a miracle that a woman her age invited Jesus into her life. We are keeping in contact with her. Praise God for working in her heart.

Bashkim is a man from Korca. During the summer he was working in Vlore. Our Volunteers met him on the promenade of the city. He said that while he was sitting there, he was so sad, felt alone and was praying to God to give him hope. He couldn’t believe that God answered his prayer so fast. Bashkim was so happy and grateful to meet our volunteers. They shared the Good News with him, encouraged him and prayed for his needs. He is thirsty to read the Bible and to go to church. ## Angola



The following are reports sent to us by Bro. Emmanuel the leader of Every Home for Christ in Angola. “I’m evangelist Bernardo Paulino, from the province of Huambo. I’m an evangelism leader and missions co-ordinator at Time of Change Christian Fellowship. In advance, I want to thank Every Home for Christ Angola for all the help you have given us with the literature and methods of evangelism.

Regarding the evangelistic tracts that we have received from Every Home for Christ Angola, they have been of great help to us, as they have facilitated the way we preach the Gospel, especially if we compare with the days when we could only use the Bible and did not have any leaflets. During our evangelistic events we meet people who are interested in hearing the Word of the Lord and then we can provide them with leaflets and leave them our contact details. This has been of great blessing to us.

Since we started preaching the Word using the tracts from EHC Angola the one that has caused the greatest impact is “Where will you spend Eternity”, because we, as human beings, do need to reflect on the reality of eternity. We have a lifetime here on earth, but

eternity is of course much more important than our earthly existence. That’s why this leaflet has impacted so many people as it has led many to reflect on eternity. For example, last Saturday I had the opportunity to preach about eternity to a group of young people. Some confessed that they had never heard anyone ever talk about eternity. They were amazed to hear about that!

I really like this material because it presents verses that make it easier to share the Gospel with listeners. This literature has greatly facilitated the way I evangelise because each leaflet bears a title such as “Four Things that God wants you to know”, etc., and that helps us to focus our message and to present it in a more summarised and objective way.

In the leaflet, the phrase “Where will you spend Eternity” invites both those who preach and those who listen to engage in a profound reflection. The Lord shows that even if we close our eyes to eternity it is quite real and very present. We want to encourage you to continue with this work and may the Lord bless you.”

Firstly, I want to give my gratitude for the organisation Every Home for Christ in Angola that has benefited our evangelistic campaigns through the material provided. Talking about the leaflet “A Heavenly Invitation”, I want to say that it is a very effective and a very useful piece of literature. I have shared this leaflet a lot with families in general. It is an essential literature, as it presents the Person of the Lord Jesus as it is mentioned in Matthew, where it says: “Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest”. We can see, in our Angolan society, many people tired of their own sins, be it prostitution, drunkenness or destroyed families. Therefore, we have used this material with the aim to reach families so that they have a positive attitude before the presence of the Lord. The most important thing about this leaflet,

is the statement that we cannot pay for our own salvation. The Lord Jesus called us, reached us and brought this invitation into our lives with the aim of taking us to live with Him in the heavenly city.”

After the literature was distributed we could see different reactions, we witnessed a lot of people feeling moved as they could see hope, that no matter what kind of sin you committed or the kind of life you’ve led, there’s a light at the end of the tunnel, everything is possible. Jesus Christ died for you and can still change your life, making you a new creature, you just need to believe in the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. This literature has been a great contribution, because in it the message is organised in a systematic way, with themes and headings so that we can share the message with people who need the Gospel.



Please continue to pray for all the large financial needs of the ministry. Paper now costs about £1,000.00 per tonne and we are using at least 5 Tonnes of paper each working day. During January we took delivery of 125 Tonnes of paper which is just one of our costs.

# 75th Anniversary

## Every Home Crusade

In 1960 Ernie and Kathleen Allen decided to commence an evangelistic outreach programme in Northern Ireland, with the aim of reaching every home with a piece of Gospel literature. They had heard from Oswald J. Smith (below) about "Every Home Crusade" being conducted in other countries. The first county to be targeted was Co Fermanagh where a group of Christians joined Ernie in visiting each home in the towns and villages with a Gospel leaflet.



After Co Fermanagh, attention turned to Co Tyrone and then Co Londonderry. Up until this time most of the printing had been done at the Outlook Press in Rathfriland. (Top right - Ernie coming from the Outlook Press with his first leaflet for distribution). However, in 1964 Ernie purchased a small printing machine, a Multilith 1250, and this was installed in the front room of the Allen home in Oakland Avenue.

Two years later, due to the kindness of Mr David Ferran, Ernie was able to purchase premises at 285 Newtownards Road. This building was formerly a shop and a team of volunteer workers helped to renovate the building to provide a reception area, an office, a store

room and a dispatch room.

With the visitation programme to reach homes throughout Northern Ireland well under way, Every Home Crusade began to reach out to the rest of the British Isles.

However, Ernie was not content to stop there. He realised that there were millions around the globe who had never heard nor read the Gospel message. As he prayed, the Lord answered in an amazing way.

In 1965 Miss Pixie Caldwell (below) returned on furlough from missionary service in Nigeria. After the death of her father she was going through his papers and came across a tract from Every Home Crusade. Pixie wrote to Mr Allen about the need for literature in Nigeria. He replied saying that he had been looking for an open door into Africa. Through that open door hundreds of thousands of Scripture tracts, booklets, leaflets and Gospels have entered Nigeria since 1965. Initially all the tracts were in English but later literature was provided in the Hausa and Fulfulde languages.

After Nigeria



letters began to come in from Ghana, Uganda, Liberia and many other countries. The Lord, who had been the instigator of this ministry, was present at every stage and His leading and timing were perfect.
