Dear Friend, During this upcoming year of 2024 we will be celebrating the 75th Anniversary of Revival Movement Association. It was during 1949 when Ernest Allen started to publish booklets on the subject of Revival. As we look back over 75 years the phrase “Great is Thy faithfulness” found in Lamentations 3:23, comes clearly to mind. We want to lift up our praise to the Lord for His unchanging reliability and for His constant guidance and presence in the ministry. It has been tremendous to see His faithfulness at work these 75 years and to be able to trust His unwavering promises to us in so many different aspects of this work. During the year we will have an article each month demonstrating how the Lord has guided the ministry to grow and develop.



On the 6th November we sent a pallet to CEF in Ethiopia consisting of 3,000 copies of “Joy to the World” Flashcards in the Amharic language.

On the 6th November we shipped 11 pallets of Scripture Calendars and Gospels to Bibel Mission for their 1 to 10 project. This literature was in the Ukrainian, Russian, Romanian and Bulgarian languages.

On the 7th November we shipped 2 pallets consisting of 3,800 CEF Flashcard Bible Lessons in the Portuguese language to Guinea Bissau. On the same date we shipped 2 pallets to CEF Sao Tome and Principe, 2 Pallets to CEF Cape Verde, and one pallet to CEF Mozambique.

On the 14th November we shipped 135,000 Scripture Calendars in the Romanian language on 5 pallets to Paul Williams. These will be distributed through many Gospel Halls throughout Romania.

On the 14th November we shipped 1 pallet of literature to CEF in Malta.

On the 14th November we shipped a container to Diguna Mission in Kenya - most of the literature in this container was for the BES ministry. We shipped them 133,000 Booklets. We also included 1,600,000 Gospel tracts for the work of Every Home for Christ in Kenya.

On the 20th November we shipped a container to our depot in Nigeria. We included in this container 3 Million Gospel tracts and 50,000 Gospels of John. We included 130,000 BES booklets for the work of Emmaus in Nigeria. Also we sent 100,000 Mailbox Club booklets for their ministry. Every Home for Christ received 260,000 Gospels Tracts.

On the 23rd November we sent 44,000 “Why Christmas”

booklets in the Romanian language to Claire Bain.

On the same day we shipped 39,000 “Why Christmas” booklets in the Spanish language and 26,000 “Why Christmas” booklets in the Basque language to Derek French and to Baptist Missions in Spain.

On the 22nd November we shipped 220,000 Gospels of John in the Romanian, Russian and Ukrainian languages to CMI Aid working primarily in Moldova.

4th of December we shipped a container to Mailbox Club in South Sudan - we included 200,000 Explorer booklets in this shipment.

On the 7th December we shipped 2 pallets of Spanish literature consisting of 500,000 Gospel Tracts and 450 Flashcard Bible Lessons for the ministry of Every Home for Christ in Costa Rica, Central America.

On the same day we shipped literature to CEF in Estonia and to CEF in a restricted country. We also shipped 5 pallets of literature to Every Home for Christ in Paraguay consisting of 500,000 Gospel tracts, 20,000 Gospels of John, and 1,600 New Testaments all in the Spanish language.

On the 12th December we shipped 2 Pallets to Zimbabwe and 2 pallets to South Africa - all of these pallets consisted of Mailbox Club booklets.

On the 13th December we shipped a container - mostly Gospels of John to a restricted country.

On the 15th December we shipped a container to Mailbox Club in Ethiopia - this consisted of 150,000 Explorers Vol. 1 with Teachers guides all in the Amharic language.

On the 18th December we shipped a container to Mailbox Club in Eswatini, Southern Africa.

Child Evangelism Fellowship have been expanding their ministry in recent years by conducting Christmas Party Clubs (CPC). These are meetings for children based around the Christmas message but presenting the Gospel - they are conducted in places where there are no regular children's meetings. Through Christmas Party Clubs many children are hearing the Gospel for the first time through volunteers who have been trained. It is hoped that new Good News Clubs will be formed as a result of these Christmas Clubs. We in the Revival Movement Association printed and shipped around 70,000 Flashcard lessons for these clubs this past year.

The following is a collection of testimonies from Christmas Party Clubs conducted in the last few weeks in the Philippines.

"In one of our CPCs in school, a pupil asked if we were Christians. When I answered yes, he replied, "Ahh that's why". Curious about the comment, I asked why.



"Because the teaching is so clear" was his encouraging reply. Praise the Lord for working in the heart of this pupil to be able to spot the difference in our teaching from those teaching religion in the school." CPC Volunteer Teacher.

I was teaching a Grade 5 class, when I noticed a young boy sitting at the front with a head covering. Right away I thought he was a Muslim and I began praying that God would speak to his heart. I was listening intently





to his answers especially when I mentioned the Lord Jesus. We just started the Bible lesson when he excused himself to attend their class called Madrasah. Sad that he had to go, I kept teaching knowing that it is the Holy Spirit's work to convict the hearts of the children. After some time, the boy came back and listened attentively to the teaching. Most importantly, he prayed to receive Jesus when the invitation was given! Hallelujah, what joy that was for me! We did not have time for individual counselling, but I leave it to God who is able to make the seed that was planted to grow and bear fruit. (CPC Volunteer Teacher)

It almost took us eight hours of travel, plus going up a hanging bridge in order to reach our CPC

destination. Praise God for making the trip possible. Brgy. San Fernando, Jiabong Western Samar is one of the many communities (barangays) with unreached children. I am beyond blessed to be used by the Lord in the salvation of children there, also the parents and teachers who professed to receive Jesus in their hearts as Saviour. Glory to God.

Last November 4, we went to an Aeta community in San Rafael, Montalban, Rizal to bring not just goodies but God's gift of eternal life to the children there. It was challenging because we had to walk at some point carrying the goodies, and then ride a boat at another point. But all our efforts paid off when we saw the precious smiles of the little ones who trusted Jesus to save them from their sins. From the 51 kids who heard the message of salvation, 43 of them professed faith in Jesus. Additionally, we were able to share the Gospel to the parents present during our teaching! What a blessing! Glory to God for opening doors to conduct CPC. On November 30th, right after our CPC seminar, we were given the chance to use our Christmas lesson in a birthday party celebration in Quezon, Bukidnon! 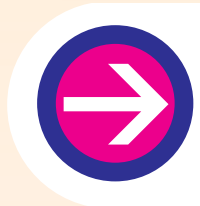
These were the normal reactions of all who attended the training and how they enjoyed sharing the message of salvation at this season.

75th ANNIVERSARY

The Revival Movement Association was founded 75 years ago by Mr William Ernest Allen, a young man born near Hillsborough, who was converted in 1933. Ernie and his four sisters were deeply impacted by the godly life of their mother, Martha Girvan. Indeed, when Ernie was born in April 1918 she told the rest of the family that he was going to be a missionary.

Ernie's conversion, at the age of 15, had a profound effect on his life. He later said, "In 1936 God called me to devote my life to the evangelisation of the world. During the years that followed He led me to study the great revivals of the past and the influence they had on the spread of the Gospel. Living for years in the Word of God and under the teaching of the Holy Spirit, and looking on the struggles, prayers, labours and triumphs of men like Wycliffe, Tyndale, Luther and those who followed them, I began to see that the greatest days of the church had been the days of revival. Every movement that has blessed the world originated from vital blessing in some soul."

In 1938 Ernie went to the Bible College of Wales in Swansea where he studied for ten years. This prolonged time at Swansea (due to World War II) taught Ernie many valuable lessons, including trusting God to supply all his needs and learning to wait on God in prayer. For nearly ten years the writings of reformers and revivalists were the tools God used to stimulate, stir and shape Ernie to seek God for revival.



In 1949 Ernie compiled seven Revival Series booklets, which were published under the name of Revival Publishing, and were circulated worldwide. Upon his return to Northern Ireland, Ernie devoted his time to the ministry and began to accept invitations to speak at churches, halls and conferences.

The Revival Publishing name was changed to Revival Movement Association and was formally inaugurated on 19th January 1952 with Dr Oswald J Smith of the People's Church in Toronto, Canada subsequently taking on the role of Honorary President and Ernie that of General Secretary.

Following reports of revival in northwest Scotland, early in 1953 Ernie invited Duncan Campbell to take a series of meetings in Northern Ireland. These meetings were very well attended and challenging to those who came.

During ten years of revival ministry, Ernie never forgot the early promise God had given him – "If you give your life to me I will give you a life of blessing." In 1953 Ernie married Kathleen Hull from Portavogie who proved to be an able partner in the ministry. The 1950's were a decade of blessing. Over 100,000 booklets and magazines were circulated in many countries, challenging Christians to seek God for revival. Reports came from all around the world of people who had been blessed by reading the "Revival Series" booklets. The stage was set for the expansion of the ministry.
